Re: GRANT CHEQUES

The grant portion of the student award program can only be issued after the start of the second half (the second term does not start until January 18). Due to supplemental tests, etc., cheques will be issued in accordance with the schedule listed below.

These cheques can only be issued to students in good standing and on the assumption that they are going to be in attendance for the full school year.

The Registrar must certify that the student is duly registered in the second term and is attending classes regularly before the Financial Aids Officer can issue the cheque to the student.

Should a student who has received a grant cheque withdraws before completing the year, he must repay a pro-rated amount of the grant cheque to the Department of University Affairs.
