


## A great place to learn



## Career choices in Business Studies



### **Business**

(2-year Ontario College Diploma, London, Woodstock)

It takes a broad set of skills and knowledge to get ahead in today's business world. Fanshawe's two-year Business program is intended to give you that important general business know-how, but also to allow you the flexibility to choose and align courses to best achieve your personal career goals.

You'll complete a foundation semester, and be expected to meet learning outcomes in a number of mandatory courses, and then select from a variety of skill areas including computer technology. Your good communication, writing, math, concentration and study skills will be needed as you learn how to solve business problems and work effectively as a member of a team. You may also tackle challenging case studies so you have the opportunity to apply what you have learned.

The broad-based education will give you the practical skills you need to accept an entrylevel position in business or industry, in government or in not-for-profit agencies. Students who graduate can begin their working career or transfer into another of Fanshawe's business programs, and earn a second diploma.

Whether your goal is to work for a large employer, a small family-run business, or to start your own company, Fanshawe's Business program will allow you to explore your potential and prepare you for the realities of an exciting and changing business world.

### **Business - Accounting**

(2-year Ontario College Diploma, optional co-op, London)

Fanshawe's two-year program in Business – Accounting is designed to prepare you to work in an accounting environment at the intermediate level. It offers two admissions a year and a co-op option to allow you to gain experience while working.

The workload is heavy, but for those who are ready to give it all they've got, the rewards are great. You'll learn the basics of the business world in the first semester and then quickly get down to studying detailed accounting principles and concepts.

Whether you hope to work directly with clients, or prefer spending your days on a computer, there are jobs to suit your desires and skills.

Graduates of Fanshawe's Business – Accounting program find employment in business, industry and government. Graduates have the opportunity to earn seven credits toward a Certified General Accountant (CGA) designation, may transfer to the third year of Fanshawe's Business – Administration Accounting program, or transfer credits to degree programs at a number of universities.

### **Business Administration - Accounting**

(3-year Ontario College Advanced Diploma, optional co-op, London)

Quite simply, Fanshawe College is the faster way to becoming a Certified General Accountant (CGA). Accounting is a career that can take you to the top. Professional accountants are in high demand at every level of management in most top firms, and a CGA designation can give you a distinct edge.

In Fanshawe's Business Administration-Accounting program, you will have the opportunity to earn thirteen of eighteen credits needed to obtain a CGA designation in just three years and four months. The CGA educational program outside the college takes a minimum of six years.

Fanshawe's program is less expensive than pursuing the designation through CGA, offers a lower student to teacher ratio, and employs excellent instructors to lead you through a challenging program.

Fanshawe's program of professional studies will give you the knowledge and skills to succeed, and we'll prepare you to write the exams required to achieve professional designation. No matter where in the business world that your career takes you, that designation tells employers you have the skills, dedication and integrity to be a leader.

### **Business - Human Resources**

#### (2-year Ontario College Diploma, Woodstock)

There has seldom been a better time to consider a career in Human Resources. A growing recognition of the importance of HR planning and management, and a growing need for HR professionals makes Fanshawe's Human Resources program an excellent choice.



#### (2-year Ontario College Diploma, London)

As the general insurance industry in Canada continues to grow, the need for skilled insurance professionals is on the rise. Graduates of Fanshawe's Insurance program are in high demand, and Fanshawe College offers one of only two insurance programs in Ontario.



(2-year Ontario College Diploma, optional co-op, London)



Graduates who achieve a minimum grade in core courses and in the program overall may be eligible to write the Certified Financial Planner™ (CFP™) examination, a prerequisite to earning their CFP designation. This is the most widely accepted designation for financial planners in the world.

### Law Clerk

(2-year Ontario College Diploma, optional co-op, London)

As a graduate of the Law Clerk program, you will work as part of a team in law firms, corporate legal departments, financial institutions, insurance companies, legal technology providers, title insurance companies and Federal, Provincial and Municipal Governments. Law clerks/paralegals also appear as agents in Small Claims Court and Provincial Offences Court as well as Government Boards and Tribunals. Depending upon your choice of career path, you could find yourself preparing trial documentation, interviewing witnesses, arranging trial dates and adjournments, drafting corporate/commercial documentation, completing Family Law Act financial statements, administering estates, negotiating leases, administering contracts, completing legal research, searching titles or processing real estate transactions.

At Fanshawe, you will learn about many areas of Canadian law including criminal law, civil litigation, corporate commercial, debtor and creditor rights, landlord and tenant, estate administration, family law and contracts.
