Application for admission--September, 1971

Students presently attending Fanshawe College who expect to return in September, 1971 are reminded that they must submit an application form. Returning students are required to complete only page 3 of the form. No other information or documentation is required.

Students, must be specific in designating the name of the second or third course to which they expect to proceed.

An application fee in the amount of \$20.00 must accompany the tuition form. This application fee will be applied to the tuition fee.

Application forms are now available at the Office of the Registrar. Every returning student should submit a form before the end of this school year. This will ensure that a place will be reserved for students who expect to return and will enable the College staff to plan more effectively for 1971-72.

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Summer Employment with S. W. E. E. P.

Under Project S. W. E. E. P. (Students Working in an Environmental Program), the Ontario Government is providing summer employment for some 2,000 students. The project is being administered equally and jointly by the Department of Lands and Forests and the Department of Energy and Resources Management.

Types of Project:

- a) Clean-up of solid wastes--litter along streams and lakeshores, along rural roads, and at unofficial dumping places.
- b) Clean-up and maintenance of conservation areas over and above the normal program with particular emphasis on small areas which are normally unmanned.
- c) Support activities such as clerical work to carry out S. W. E. E. P. office work and to offset any increased load on the regular conservation authority-office staff.

Students interested in this program may obtain an application form at the Student Placement Office, Room 212.

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Student Union Positions

BUSINESS MANAGER--Duties include (but not restricted to) operation of the Student Union office and maintenance of the financial records of the Student Union.

A background of typing, accounting, business administration, and possibly shorthand is preferable for this position.

EXECUTIVE SECRETARY

Duties: "Shall prepare.....all Agendas, Reports, Minutes, and Resignations. Shall be responsible for the mailing or posting of all notices and/or agendas of the SAC meetings."

Also responsible for SAC correspondence and other documents pertaining to the Student Union activities.

Applications for this part-time position should include salary or honorarium expectations.

PUBLICITY COORDINATOR

Duties: Responsible for promotion and publicity of Student Union activities.

Applicants for this part-time position should have credentials in the field of Communications or be enrolled in the Communication Arts program of Fanshawe College. Applications should include salary or honorarium expectations.

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From the Financial Aids Office

The Ontario Student Award program is designed to supplement the student's own resources to pay for his education in a post-secondary institution. One resource, which the student must have is summer savings, as follows:

- \$300.00 first year (male and female)
- \$500.00 second year (female)
- \$600.00 second year (male)
- \$600.00 third year (female)
- \$700.00 third year (male)

Since some students may find difficulty in obtaining summer employment, documentary evidence to support their claim that employment was not available MUST be furnished. The usual accepted evidence is a weekly statement from Canada Manpower Centre showing that the student has registered and applied for work each week during the summer. Where such evidence is furnished, the student may be relieved of the amount of summer savings on a review of the amount of the award allotted following the initial application.

Students are urged to be sure to produce this evidence if they find themselves unable to obtain summer employment, or to make the necessary savings from whatever employment they do find.

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* OPERATION PLACEMENT - OPERATIONAL *

Our summer employment office - OPERATION PLACEMENT - is now a physical reality. Operating out of temporary quarters at 120 Queen's Ave., they have already registered over 3,500 job-seeking students. Jobs are not "pouring in" but the trickle is beginning and to date about 153 students have been placed in employment.

The London Board of Control have come up with more suitable accomodation for the operation. About the 7th. of May the shop will move to 97 Dundas St. - not an impressive-looking establishment but a very functional one.

OPERATION PLACEMENT is, of course, a co-operative effort between Fanshawe, U.W.O., the Chamber of Commerce, the Inter-City Youth Council and Canada Manpower.

Manpower has supplied one full-time counsellor and has hired five students to assist him (one from Fanshawe). The 'phone number are 432-5751 and 432-5781. But don't 'phone - go down and see them - not just once but once a week for a few weeks. The better known you make yourself, the better your chances are.
