An artist of international stature, Eric Atkinson of London, Ontario returns to England this spring for an exhibit of his recent work at Park Square Gallery, Leeds, June 2 to 30.

The exhibit includes a collection of 30 drawings and four paintings influenced by Mr. Atkinson's visit to Mexico in 1973.

While in Leeds, Mr. Atkinson will lecture on Art Education in Canada.
